The lesser the use of oxygen, the lesser is blindness in premature babies as it prevents Retinopathy of prematurity (ROP- leading cause of blindness in preterm neonates).

Very Satisfying was the association of "Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan School," which gave us the opportunity to talk to their students and so many of them were encouraged to join us for the good work. I was admitted at Rainbow Hospital due to a complication in my pregnancy and was suddenly told that I would have to deliver my baby immediately. It was certainly the most stressful point in my life. When baby was born, we knew his lungs were developed and are in good shape. None the less there were many complications. He was on oxygen support for a couple of weeks, had episodes of Apnea and bradycardia many times. 6 weeks in the NICU was hard but my baby is healthy and back home now.

The financial and mental burden is something that can be very stressful for most parents and I can vouch that Extra Mile Foundation will help as many families as they can to overcome their fears and worries.

I'm thrilled to be a volunteer for Extra Mile and would help in whichever way I can.

bility to provide equal opportunity for good health and education to all. Unfortunately very few nations are able to do that.


Especially in a country like ours, where tertiary health care is provided mainly by private hospitals and expenditure is out of

Extreme Premature baby of 25 weeks and birth weight being 600 gms

Extra Mile supported both the twins of these parents. But unfortunately they lost one of the twins. The second twin was discharged home. Our involvement helped in decreasing the financial stress to this family.



Late Preterm baby who needed ventilator support



This baby was a late preterm of 36wks and birth weight being 2kgs., was admitted at Rainbow Children hospital for hight ventilator support to save his live. Father didn't have money for admission fees as well. Extra Mile helped this baby to go home safely by sharing a part of financial burden.

Premature baby admitted for a month in the hospital



Baby of Dibamma bai with 31 weeks was admitted for a month in Durgabhai Deshmukh hospital. Extra Mile helped this baby to go home by contributing to their exhausted financial resources.

First set of Extramile twins from Vizag.

Shaping The Future

An Extra Mile to Prevent Retinopathy of prematurity (ROP)



Preterm infants are at risk of ROP as the blood vessels in their retinas are not fully developed at birth. In ROP the retinal blood vessels initially stop growing, and then proliferate abnormally. The end result can be total retinal detachment or scarring and distortion of the retina, which leads to blindness. Carefull supplementation of oxygen is one of the most preventable cause of ROP. Instead of providing free flow oxygen (5l or more), if we use low flow meters which can provide oxygen of 0.5 litres or even lesser, will not only prevent oxygen toxicity but also save the resources. As an Extra Mile Initiative we will be

providing these low flowmeters to various SNCU's like Nalgonda, Warangal, Siddipet, Durgabai Deshmukh and Durresehwar Hospital which cater more than 10,000 preterm babies per year.

Warangal SNCU visit



Visit to Warangal SNCU's was a very satisfying experience. This is a clear example of how rapid scaling up of SNCU's in the country has accelerated the reduction of neonatal mortality. Extra Mile will be associated and support the much needed population of newborns and premature babies.

Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's Public School visit



One of the moments which Extra Mile Family will always cherish is visit to Bhartiya Vidya Bhavan school and spreading awareness about prematurity to the students of the school and their parents. These students will participate in various activities as an act of "Giving back to the society is a moral responsibility" and hence build the future.



Wayde van Niekerk

When Wayde van Niekerk was born prematurely at 29 weeks in 1992, nobody could have imagined that he would grow up to be the reigning champion in the field of track and field. He weighed a little over 1kg and doctors said he could end up being disabled. He is the current World and Olympic record holder, having set the record in the Olympic finals. He also holds the world-best time in the 300 metres. Wayde won South Africa's first gold medal at the 2016 Rio Olympics.




