The journey became most gratifying with our annual event 'Premiethon', where we could bring more than 2000 people to Run for The Cause, and spread awareness that these premature babies can be saved. ## **Our Share of Smiles**

#### Late preterm baby who needed critical intensive care

Baby of Anusha Ankar is a 58 day old late preterm (36weeks) baby boy of birth weight 2.25kg. Baby was in Rainbow Children's Hospital for 8weeks and needed critical intensive care. Parents were completed exhausted with all the resources. Extra Mile helped them with financial support in hospital and post discharge for special feeds on before which baby needs to thrive.



#### Baby with hypertrophic pyloric stenosis

This baby was brought to emergency room of Rainbow children's hospital with in shock due to persistent vomitings and probable sepsis and needed urgent surgery (was diagnosed with hypertrophic pyloric stenosis). Father is a lorry driver he got salary 10000/- per month. Extra Mile supported family for the surgical intervention.



#### Baby with persistent hypoglycemia

Baby of Afreen Begum is 36 weeks 1.6kgs, admitted in Butterfly Hospital at around 13 days of life. This baby came from warangal with persistent HYPOGLYCAEMIA (low sugar levels), and was on CPAP(small ventilator). Baby was completely encephalopathic (poor activity and delayed brain responses) and had severe infection in blood. Father is a GYM trainer he got a salary 15000/-and was not able to afford hospital care. Extra Mile helped them financially



during the course of treatment and he is now with normal sugar levels and improved sepsis, feeding by himself.

#### Baby who needed cardiac surgery

This baby needed an urgent cardiac surgery for a life threatening disease (severe coarctation of aorta) at Rainbow Cardiac Institute. Father is an Agriculturist at Warangal with income 4167/-month. Extra Mile supported them with cost of surgery when he was exhausted with all his savings and borrowed money from relatives and friends and now unable to afford further treatment.

#### Twins with critical illness



Twin babies of Taslima were admitted with prematurity and critical illness at Durgabai Deshmukh Hospital. Father is an employee in small firm and could not afford the cost of care for two babies. Extra mile supported parents for one of the twins.

#### Baby with respiratory distress



Baby was born at (36-37 weeks )with low birth weight (2.1).Baby was born with respiratory distress, and was very sick needing high neonatal care at Paramitha Hospital. Father is an computer operator salary 15000/-per month. This baby needed hospital stay for another 2 weeks after initial treatment, where Extra Mile supported the family.

#### Twin babies who needed prolonged NICU stay



Twin babies of Venkata Laxmi were born premature at (29+2weeks) with very low birth weight of 1.1kg. They Need prolonged hospital stay, and father being agriculturist was not able to afford care for twin babies. Extra Mile foundation helped the babies to go home.

#### Baby admitted for critical cardiac surgery



Baby of Hanshith was admitted at Rainbow heart institute for critical cardiac surgery. Father is security personal. Extra Mile foundation helped him to undergo the critical surgery. TAPVC REPAIR

#### Baby with persistent oxygen dependency

Baby of Roja was admitted for preterm, respiratory distress and required surfactant. Baby also had large pda and severe pphn. Baby was kept on mechanical ventilation. Baby had persistent oxygen dependency and was on nasal prongs o2.



#### Baby who needed prolonged NICU stay

Baby of Pooja twin II a preterm(26+5weeks)
Baby girl weight 1.013kgs delivered by emergency (LSCS)
In view of extreme prematurity with very low birth weight,
baby needed prolonged NICU stay and father is a driver
by occupation. Extra Mile foundation helped them to
reach an extra mile when their all resources were exhausted.

Father is a farmer with income of 10,000/per month. He exhausted all his savings and borrowed money from relatives and friends and now unable to afford further treatment. Considering their financial background, extramile foundation has supported the treatment for this baby, with a potential for a favorable outcome.

Extra mile

I am Dr. Damera Yadaiah SNCU, Nodal Officer Nalgonda. We, SNCU Nalgonda have been associated with Extra mile since last 12 months in improving the Newborn survival. Extra mile is supporting our unit in Breastfeeding practice.. mainly in feeding the sick babies with Expressed Breastmilk. We have been provided with adequate



number of Breast Pumps to use in sncu, Kangaroo mother care unit and Postnatal ward. We are able to procure more amount of EBM when compared to mannual expression. Our mothers, babies and staff are satisfied with new initiative because less number of complaints from mother such as Not Enough milk. Other important initiative undertaken by Extramile is Low Flow meters...to give more appropriate titrated Oxygen therapy to Preterm, and Babies with Perinatal asphyxia. We also found these Low Flowmeters in babies with Bronchopulmonary dysplasia. We are able to use Oxygen judiciously and reduce Oxygen consumption in the unit. We are planning to assess ROP in preterm and LBW weight babies since usage of Low Flowmeters. We... from SNCU Nalgonda sincerely express our gratitude to the Extramile for all the support. Looking forward to have a long association with you all.







## Mentor's Note

#### Extra Mile Foundation

Health care is most fundamental for the development and prosperity of any country. While almost all the countries are faced with the challenges of providing good quality health care to their people, this problem is much greater in low income countries. Availability, affordability and accessibility continue to be major challenges. Hardly any government among the developing countries provides adequate financial resources to heath care. The two vulnerable age groups children and the elderly are most affected.



India has the largest number births in the world (about25 million annually) and among these, the rate of premature births is very high (around 3.5 million). These babies are vulnerable to multiple health problems which demand the highest levels of quality of medical care. In our country regretfully, such care is not available to the vast majority of these babies. Inadequate number of facilities, trained Human resources, exorbitant cost and limited access are the major factors.


The EXTRA MILE FOUNDATION, an initiative of a neonatologist, Dr. Nitasha Bagga, is working to create a model to make this care available to babies of disadvantaged families. Her mission to provide care, train professionals in the care of premature babies and raising public awareness through advocacy with fellow professionals and philanthropists is laudatory. Her early record provides glimpses of promise such programmes hold. If this pilot project succeeds, it should be replicated and scaled up both by this foundation and others across the country.

Support from philanthropists, foundations and institutions will go a long way to make this a reality. Larger scale up will then be the responsibility of the government. These should succeed as this means saving lives of these babies and avoid lifelong disabilities.
